

Open Call for participation in the Performance Lab

This 1-year-long, all-inclusive laboratory is part of the Open Up project & will allow you to **learn techniques and practices** used in the field of **live performance** by experienced artists and educators from the fields of dance, physical theatre, music, voice work, performance art, live art. Participants will enter a European network of artists and professional trainers and will have the opportunity to make connections in Cyprus and abroad. All participants will receive a certificate of participation at no cost.

It will take place on **Saturdays from January to December 2021** at **Theatro Polis – OPAP** (10-12 Tempon Street, 1016 Nicosia), which is located in the Old City Centre of **Nicosia**. The lab is **free of charge**.

Profile of participants:

- Have a strong interest in expanding their knowledge and experience in a kind of performing or performance practice (dance, theatre, music, voice work, performance, live art)
- Have some previous experience in a performance practice (this could have been on stage, in a studio, or in community gatherings)
- Aim at eventually creating their own artistic identity by developing their own practice (with the help of the Open Up team)
- Have a good knowledge of the English language (as workshops will be in English)
- Availability and willingness to follow the one-year-long commitment of the programme
- Be over 18 years old
